Secretary, GMDA, Shri Sazzad Alam, ACS presided over the meeting. After welcoming all members Secretary requested all members to evaluate the technical bids received for the work "Extension of Noonmati basin drain up to ASIDC point to Bamunimaidan [{"construction of underground RCC storm water box drain and open drain from Assam Small Scale Industries Development Corporation (Bamunimaidan to Noonmati Refinery areas) to Noonmati basin drain".

The committee then go through all the 3(three) bids received namely i) Shri Tara Chand Sarawgi ii) M/S Hi-tech Construction iii) MBL-CICON (JV). After detail scrutiny and threadbare discussion a **Comparative Statement / Table for Evaluation of substantive responsiveness of technical bids** is prepared. From the comparative statement following observations are noticed
